INAUGURAL ADDRESS

ear brothers, friends, and Claretian family: all of you present here at this moment of prayer and those who participate online,

Today at the Congregational level, we open the 175th anniversary of the foundation of our beloved Congregation. On July 16, the Major Organisms and communities will have specific events to launch the jubilee year at the local level.

This is a year of grace, a Kairos moment for us to enkindle the fire of God's love that the Spirit inflamed our Founder, St. Anthony Mary Claret and his companions. St. Claret discovered the depth of his missionary vocation in the same passage of Isiah that Luke uses to present Jesus' vocation: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me to proclaim the Good News to the poor."

Our Founder started the Congregation because he was convinced that this spirit was given also to others and his work was not a solitary mission but a mission "to do with others".

This charismatic gift spread throughout the world and widened the Claretian family in the Church with several branches in it. We have received the same spirit of our Founder, and today we are to be on fire with God's love and radiate the light of the Gospel around us in a Claretian way together with all those who have the same gift.

Jubilee is a time to be grateful for the gift of the charism and for the great missionaries whose lives bloomed in the charism for the glory of God, the salvation of souls, and their



sanctification. We think of our Founder, Co-founders, the Claretian martyrs, the Superiors General, and a great multitude of missionaries who form a community in heaven interceding for us. We thank the Lord for every missionary of the Claretian family who keeps alive the fire of God's love in their hearts and let it shine brightly in the various peripheries of human struggles.

We live in an epoch of amazing technological advancement, globalization and interconnectedness, information accessibility, environmental awareness, growing social fragmentation, confusion of values, dehumanizing poverty, irrational exploitation of nature, and other ills of our times.

Amidst this complex reality marked by volatility, uncertainty, and ambiguity, the only way to be faithful to our missionary vocation is to be rooted in Christ and our missionary charism and have the courage to walk through the uncertainties of our times with the light of Christ. Such a journey cannot be one of isolation but together on the synodal path.

I would like to begin this prayer session with a symbolic action which I hope would represent what the Lord would allow to happen in this jubilee year: that each Claretian, every community and all Major Organisms and the whole Claretian family be on fire with God's love. Without that fire, we will be like a collection of candles gathered in a candle store. With his fire burning in us, we become beams of light radiating its brightness without being burnt out. The only way to fight darkness is by lighting the lamps.

Let this be the primary aim of this Jubilee year that we are aflame with Christ's love and walk forth courageously together, spreading its flames wherever the Lord sends us on a mission.





THE LOGO

The logo was designed to be universally recognizable without the need for language or explanation while also being simple in design. The center of the logo features a **CMF** (Son of the Heart of Mary), representing something identifiable, Marian, and universal. The calligraphic typography used is simple and quick, with a slightly rounded horizontal line that "embraces" the surrounding lettering and, combined with the "**f**," creates a cross, symbolizing that God is at the center of everything (the greater glory of God). The number **175** is positioned to the right of the main element, offsetting it and giving it significance, but not making it the image's focal point.

The third component of the logo embodies the fervent blaze of the Holy Spirit. Its flames are dynamic and in constant motion, emanating from the central flame. This symbol is derived from the acronym "cmf" and perfectly complements the motto, which signifies 175 years of spreading the flame of the Spirit.

The Claretian Missionaries are the instrument of the Holy Spirit to enkindle people by all means in the fire of God's love.



We have just listened to the account of the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Community of disciples of the Lord, gathered in prayer together with Mary, the Mother of the Lord. The Spirit manifested himself as a strong wind and flames that rested on each one of them. "They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different languages."

The transforming and energizing force of this founding moment of the Church is the same as our first brothers experienced during those retreat, with which they began to live in community the gift of a new missionary charism in the Church and in the world. Gathered in that small and poor cell of the seminary of Vic, in prayer and under the patronage of the picture of the Heart of Mary, they experienced, like the Apostles, that their hearts burned with the fire of love and they were launched to burn and ignite all their brothers and sisters with the proclamation of the Gospel.

This mural we are contemplating, painted by Fr. Maximino Cerezo in 1994, is a beautiful Claretian interpretation of Pentecost. Called to follow Jesus like the Apostles, we know that we are called by Mary, the Woman filled with the Spirit. She is our Mother, Formator and Foundress. With her we learn to open ourselves with docility to the transforming action of the Spirit. She urges us to go out of ourselves to embark on the new paths that the Spirit opens for the mission, as our last General Chapter reminds us: "We dream of a Congregation, audacious and itinerant that, sent by the Spirit of the Lord (cf. Lk 4:18; Acts 8:28.39), goes forth towards the peripheries, approaches the youth, walks with them and encourages them to respond to the call of God" (QC 63).

How well our brother Pedro Casaldáliga captured the depth of this moment, always new, of Pentecost, when, upon contemplating this painting, he addressed Mary of Pentecost saying: "Open our ears and eyes, shake us from fear and inertia, give us a heart of flesh and chrism, endow us with joy and daring, send us, in the Wind that carries you, witnesses of your Son, deacons of Easter, servants, ecumenical brothers of the world!"

The transforming and energizing power of Pentecost was reflected very well by our Father and Founder in a concise and inspiring text that defines the identity of a son of the Immaculate Heart of Mary as a man anointed by the Spirit. The Heart of Mary forges us in that Fire of love that makes us burn, scorch and ignite the whole world. With the strength of the Spirit, it is possible to endure the sacrifices and sufferings proper to the mission. That same strength impels us to live totally centred in the following of Jesus Christ as a missionary and in the passionate search for the glory of God and the salvation of the whole world, in the style of Claret.

LETTER OF POPE FRANCIS ADDRESSED TO FATHER GENERAL



Rome, San John the Lateran, 8 July 2023

Dear Brother,
