RESOLUTIONS OF THE ACLA MEETING IN RIABA, MALABO 2026

Gathered for the Ordinary Assembly in Riaba, a historic place of the missionary presence of our Congregation in Africa, and in a spirit of communion and missionary discernment, the Major Superiors of the Major Organisms and Missions adopted the following resolutions:

- 1- To exercise authority as a service in humility in order to foster communion, responsibility in management, accountability, and transparency.
- 2- The creation of a continental SOMI team and its support by the different Major Organisms and by ACLA when there is need.
- 3- To establish an intercultural commission for the discernment of formators in order to make our houses of formation intercultural, with intercultural formators.
- 4- To strengthen leadership formation and promote a style of governance marked by listening, transparency, and fraternal closeness.
- 5- To appoint liaison persons for the different Prefectures at the ACLA level for the next triennium in order to coordinate the various activities of the Prefectures and for a better collaboration and pastoral animation.
- 6- To promote and implement the Directory of Youth and Vocational Ministry by developing a formation program for young Claretian members in our Organisms, Missions, and Communities, and by making available to the General Prefecture of Youth and Vocational Ministry five young people (Claretians and non-Claretians) to participate in the training workshop for YVM referents of the Congregation.
- 7- To make available to the General Prefecture of Youth and Vocational Ministry five young people (Claretians and non-Claretians) to participate in the training workshop for YVM referents of the Congregation.
- 8- To financially support, InCLA in its process of growth and to send students for intercultural formation that can assist in our formation centers.
- 9- To guarantee integral and quality formation. Aware that the future of the mission depends on the solidity of formation, we renew our commitment to offer serious and coherent human, spiritual, intellectual, and pastoral formation by sending students to the Novitiate of Bata.
